Treventus ScanRobot® 2.0



We have deployed two Treventus ScanRobot® 2.0 which are high speed mass digitisation systems (MDS) designed for large volume digitisation of any bound material.

The Treventus can scan up to 2,500 page per hour, it has an optical resolution of 300 dpi and it can output images in a number of formats. These images are preservation quality black and white, grayscale or full colour.

This scanner has three scanning modes including automatic scanning, semi-automatic scanning for the gentle scanning of fragile books and manual scanning for the cover, spine, and fold outs.

How the process works

Our security cleared drivers collect your books in our GPS tracked vehicles and securely deliver them to our facility.

We have a specialist team who are highly experienced and dedicated to scanning bound material. These operatives are trained in fragile material handling to ensure precious collections are protected and handled in the correct manner throughout the scanning process. The same care and professional treatment is applied to every book put through our scanning process.

For very old and delicate material we use special book cradles which ensure that the spine of the book is not harmed during the scanning process. These scanners can scan a variety of sizes up to A3.

All of the scanners we have deployed can output scanned images in a number of formats including PDF, TIFF, JPEG, PNG, etc. The scanned images can also be produced in preservation quality black and white, grayscale or full colour.

After scanning and quality control, we can process each scanned image through our highly accurate optical character recognition (OCR) software, which reads and recognises each typed word and character to allow full text retrieval.

Over the course of the last twelve years we have encountered numerous types of bound material and have built up a wealth of experience delivering these projects to the satisfaction of our clients'.
